Prevent – Prevent Duty (Section 26 of the Counter-Terrorism and Security Act 2015) is the University’s statutory duty for ‘due regard to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism’. All staff should be aware of the process of radicalisation, definitions of extremism and the process for raising concerns in this context. This training aims to support all staff in understanding their role in Prevent Duty. (<https://www.prevent.admin.cam.ac.uk>)

Equality and Diversity – The practice of ensuring that no individual or group is treated or regarded any differently on the basis of specified protected characteristics such as gender, race, religion/beliefs, disability, age or sexuality. This course outlines the main principles of E&D and its impacts.

Understanding Unconscious / Implicit Bias – Research shows that unconscious bias can heavily influence recruitment and selection decisions, specifically in relation to gender and ethnicity. This training aims to highlight the importance of recognising personal bias and the impact bias can have on decisions and interactions with others.
